The Carroll Society

In 2011, Bishop Carroll established the Carroll Society to provide an opportunity for alumni and friends to support the school's vision for educating more students in spirit, heart, mind and body within a Catholic framework, and on a superior academic foundation.

- Carroll Society donors commit \$1,000 per year for a minimum of 3 years
- A one-time gift of \$3,000 or more also earns a donor membership into the Carroll Society
- A gift of \$10,000 or more earns a donor a life membership into the Carroll Society

Donors who commit to the Carroll Society before November 30, 2011 will be considered inaugural members and will be recognized as such on a special plaque on display at the school, and on the Bishop Carroll website and other materials.

All Carroll Society donors will be recognized annually at a special reception with Bishop Carroll students, and will be acknowledged at the Carrollian gala. In addition, donors to the Carroll Society will receive a special gift from Bishop Carroll, an annual publication from Bishop Carroll's principal and CEO, special news and updates.

The Annual Fund

Annual donors are recognized on the Bishop Carroll website and in several publications every year.

Named Scholarships and Guardian Angel Fund

Used exclusively for tuition assistance, Named Scholarships can be created in the name of a donor(s) or in honor or memory of an individual or family named by the donor. Named Scholarships provide need-based financial aid to students who are currently enrolled.

- A Named Scholarship requires a minimum gift of \$500 per year for a three-year period.
- Scholarships are awarded on a non-discriminatory basis at a minimum of \$500 per student. Donors may request that recipient students meet specific qualifications, such as parish affiliation or performance in an academic subject. Scholarships are not awarded for athletics.

Gifts below \$500 intended exclusively for tuition assistance scholarships can be designated to the Guardian Angel Fund. These gifts are recognized annually as part of the Annual Fund.

Planned Giving

Leave a legacy at Bishop Carroll with a planned gift, such as:

- Retirement or life insurance plans: name Bishop Carroll as the beneficiary
